Workshop Decentralized Garden (for secondary and vocational education)

This workshop developed by designer Hugo Pilate is a playful discovery in a computer game environment. In the Decentralized Garden, you become part of a network of plants and discover what it could be like to think, feel and act like a plant. A plant that always has a strong relationship with its environment and interacts with other plants, animals and all organisms. Something that is crucial for the recovery of ever-growing ecosystems on Earth. Discover new ways to interact with the world and with each other.



Workshop The City Speaks (for secondary education)

In the city we meet in the public space. Streets, squares and parks are not just a background: they are the exact place where power and meaning are constantly questioned. You can see that by different signs. From a billboard to stickers to a written slogan, all these signs have an intentional sender. Someone wants to warn you and others without speaking to you face-to-face; for example, to provide information, to prevent you from doing something or to make a request or offer. But who is that sender? And why do they want something from you? And what would you like to tell others in the city? We will discover this in this workshop by using technology. The workshop is hosted by designer Hugo Pilate and urban geographer Rinke Vreeke.

This workshop was created through the Collision program, a collaboration of STRP and Kunstloc Brabant, who coach an artist with expertise in media/technology to develop an educational project.



About Hugo Pilate

Hugo Pilate is a French-American design researcher based in Eindhoven. One project at a time, Hugu is trying to make sense of the world we've built for ourselves while exploring alternative modes of living, earning, and thinking. He has worked in Los Angeles, Paris and Delhi for corporate and government actors engaging with a wide range of topics including access to clean energy, humanitarian aid, sexual and reproductive health, financial inclusion, and innovation at large.
